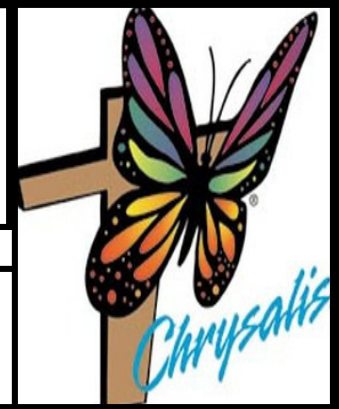

From the Community Music Director

When you sing, you dig deep roots in the Word.
Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly...singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs... (Colossians 3:16)

The Apostle Paul lays out this exhortation to let God's Word dwell in us richly, and then, he tells us how to live out that command. The first, of course, is teaching. But the second, is singing!

Singing is one of the two chief ways in which God's Word dwells in us richly. And, as we observed in the last point, singing is a command. But this command comes with a promise: As we sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs together, we are promised that the Word of Christ will dwell in us richly, which is what we should crave as believers!

Our singing is more than a warm-up for the sermon or filler in the service. Colossians 3:16 is clearly laying out for us that: Singing stands alongside of preaching as one of the two great ways that God has ordained for his Word to dwell richly in each one of us

DIRECTIONS TO GARDEN CITY CHAPEL

The street address for Garden City Chapel :**316 Dogwood Drive North, Murrells Inlet, SC**

From Mt. Pleasant / Georgetown, take Highway 17 and continue on 17 business (not bypass). Turn right onto Atlantic Avenue, at a stop light. Go almost a mile, and turn left onto Dogwood Dr N. Garden City Chapel will be on the right.

From points west and south, take Highway 17 bypass and turn left onto the Garden City Connector. At the end of the GC Connector, at the stop light, turn right onto 17 business. Turn left onto Atlantic Avenue at the stoplight. Go almost a mile, and turn left onto Dogwood Dr. N. Garden City Chapel will be on the right.

Drop your Pilgrim and their luggage off at the check-in location next to the chapel.
