MUSIC

Jesus sings.

If Scripture didn’t say it, I wouldn’t either. But it’s true. In four places in Scripture we read that Jesus, the Son of God himself, raised his voice in worship. Which is immediately confusing on one level. Of course it is not that there’s anything wrong with singing, just that I imagine our Savior much better suited as the silent *recipient* of adoration and worship ([Revelation 5:6–14](#)). But he also sings. And the only way to understand why Jesus sings is to briefly walk through some scripture passages

(this is the first of three).

First, Matthew 26:30 and Mark 14:26 are two parallel texts picturing Jesus “singing a song of praise.”

These two passages are not very long. We see that Jesus and the disciples sang a song at the end of the Lord’s Supper. Jesus lifted up his voice and sang a hymn, a customary finale to a Passover meal together. And that’s it. The biblical writers have little more to say about it.

Very likely this song was some portion of Psalm 114–118, and very likely it was sung antiphonally, meaning Jesus led the men by singing a line, and the disciples responded by singing a “Hallelujah.” Back and forth they responsively marched through a psalm in song. I imagine it was a memorable evening of reflection.

But most of the details about the song and how they sung it are left unsaid.

Jesus sang. We know that much. So, join Jesus and SING! DeColores, Lynn Tyler
