

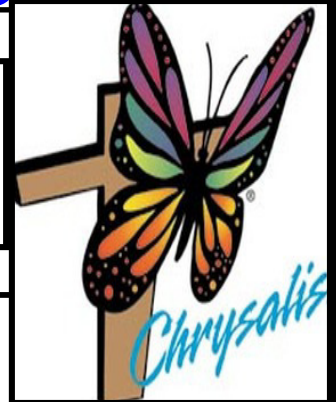

MESSAGE FROM YOUR COMMUNITY SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

When you receive this, the Men's Walk should be ready to start, and the Women's just a week away. I encourage you to do two things over the next couple of weeks.

First, pray. Prayer is not manipulating God, nor is it manipulating others. Years ago a woman walked out at the end of worship one Sunday particularly mad at me. She did not like what I had said, nor did she think I was doing what God wanted. She looked at me through squinted eyes, and said through gritted teeth, "I'm not sure you're a Christian! I don't agree with anything you say, and I want you to know, I'm putting you on my prayer list!" I thought to myself, "I be that's not the only list I'm on."

Mother Teresa said "Prayer is putting oneself in the hands of God, at His disposition, and listening to His voice in the depth of our hearts." Take time to put yourself in the hands of the One who loves you and all the pilgrims as though you were the only people in the world.

Second, do something to show your love for the pilgrims, especially if you know one or are sponsoring one. Call them the week after the walk to check up on them. Take them out for coffee. Listen to them, listen to their family. Love, like faith, without works is dead. Do something.

After all, Jesus didn't just love us. He did something. Something huge!

DIRECTIONS TO GARDEN CITY CHAPEL

The street address for Garden City Chapel is: **316 Dogwood Drive North, Murrells Inlet, SC**

From Mt. Pleasant / Georgetown, take Highway 17 and continue on 17 business (not bypass). Turn right onto Atlantic Avenue, at a stop light. Go almost a mile, and turn left onto Dogwood Dr N. Garden City Chapel will be on the right.

From points west and south, take Highway 17 bypass and turn left onto the Garden City Connector. At the end of the GC Connector, at the stop light, turn right onto 17 business. Turn left onto Atlantic Avenue at the stoplight. Go almost a mile, and turn left onto Dogwood Dr. N. Garden City Chapel will be on the right.

Drop your Pilgrim off first at the check-in location next to the chapel. Luggage can then be dropped off under the middle dorm. Parking is not allowed under the dorms, so drive your car back to the parking lot across from the chapel.
